The first day will focus on concepts that are essential building blocks for the education of the rhinoplasty surgeon. In lecture will discuss normal and variant anatomy, nasal analysis, aesthetic ideals, philosophy and planning.

The second day will focus on applying techniques for specific common problems in rhinoplasty. We begin with focused sessions on common problems addressed in rhinoplasty, such as the Hump Nose, Large Nose, Crooked Nose, Saddle Nose. In the afternoon, we have sessions on nasal reconstruction and functional problems, which will include variations in technique, avoidance of complications and alternative treatments.

The third day of the Mater's course will focus on more advanced techniques in rhinoplasty. We will emphasize critical analysis of results and debates regarding the multiple approaches to the problems discussed on day 1 & 2. During the afternoon session, focus will shift to complications of Rhinoplasty, avoidance of such complications and finally, methods of revision. Emphasis will be placed on analysis, planning and implementation in revision.
